**Understanding Wildlife Program Scheduled for Vestal High School and African Road**

There will be two free shows at both the Vestal High School auditorium and the Vestal Middle School cafeteria on that day, and the schedule is summarized below.

9:30 a.m. - VHS Auditorium; Audience is Vestal Hills and Glenwood Elementary.

1:30 p.m. - VMS Cafeteria; Audience is African Road Elementary.

In addition, there will two paid presentations at 5:30 and 7 p.m. in the Vestal High School auditorium for any parents who want to return with their children. Cost is \$5 per person for the evening shows.

The goal of the presentation is to increase students' knowledge of animals and to help them understand the need for wildlife conservation. The show includes a rain forest reproduction on stage and includes birds, monkeys, jungle cats, alligators and snakes.
