



# Kindergarten

## First Week Info & Supply List



Please have your child wear his/her tag for the first week of school. The tag should include name, address, phone #, bus #, and teacher's name.

All children should come directly to the room by entering the front doors by the office. Please allow your child to walk to the classroom on their own. There are helpers in the hallways if they need assistance. This promotes a feeling of independence and allows teachers to focus on the children as they arrive. Parent chats can be set up at a separate time.

For dismissal, the children getting picked up will be released from the cafeteria, at the end of the day, 3:20 p.m. Kindergarten children will not be released as walkers to insure safety.

Please mark all clothing and personal belongings. except for the items to be shared) You do NOT have to label individual supplies.

### Your child needs:

- \*A **full**-sized school bag (label)
- \*A paint shirt-can be an old adult T-shirt that goes over the head shirt (The plastic rips easily and buttons or ties are difficult for little hands) (label)
- \*One pocket folder (laminated cardboard lasts longer- label)
- \* 1 container of wet wipes
- \*Sneakers for phys ed.-gym (label) (They can be left in school)
- \*Two boxes of tissues (unscented) (no label)
- \*A beach towel for quiet time (label)

**Due to a limited amount of storage space, please do not send pillows, blankets, sleeping bags or mats.**

All supplies will be kept by the teacher, for all students to share.

Boxes to books is asking if you could please donate a roll of contact paper to the publishing center room.

The day you want to celebrate your child's birthday, you may send in treats before lunch or join your child for lunch. All adult lunches must be ordered by 9 a.m.

Each child brings a daily snack. Please put the snack in a different container than his/her lunch. Over anxious eaters may eat everything at lunch and not save a snack. We encourage healthy snacks such as fresh veggies, fruit, and 100% fruit juice, rather than drinks/foods with coloring or dyes. Please do not send candy.



Please call the nurse's office at 757-2356 if your child is late or absent. We will also need awritten note, on the first day back after an absence. (NYS law)



If your child comes to school late, please go to the office and get a late pass and have your child walk to the classroom.

Curriculum will be described on Curriculum Night. Report cards are sent home in November, April, February, and June. Parent conferences are in November.



Book club slips will be sent home periodically. This is an inexpensive way to build your child's personal library. There is No obligation to buy.

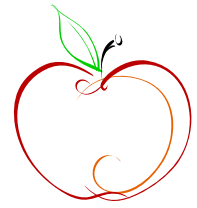

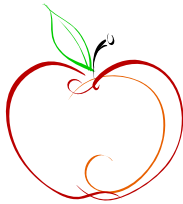

# First-Grade Supply List

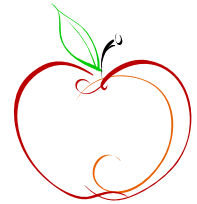


- ☺ 1 dozen sharpened #2 pencils with erasers
- ☺ 1 separate eraser
- ☺ 1 box of crayons (no larger than 24-count)
- ☺ 1 sturdy two-pocket folder labelled with your child's name
- ☺ 1 art smock with your child's name on the collar
- ☺ 1 box of tissues to share with the class
- ☺ Children's scissors with rounded ends (Fiskars are best)
- ☺ 2 glue sticks
- ☺ 1 simple pencil sharpener
- ☺ 1 SMALL pencil box to hold supplies (about 8 x 5 x 3)
- ☺ 1 highlighter



Please do not send in:

- ☹ Scented or glitter crayons
- ☹ Pens
- ☹ Trappers/binders



During the school year, please periodically ask your child if he/she needs to replace any supplies (especially crayons, erasers, pencils, pencil sharpener or glue sticks). Please put your child's name on all supplies.



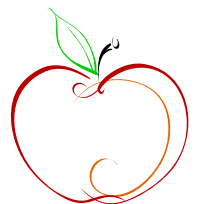
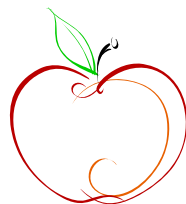
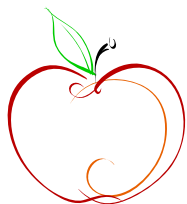
Your child may also bring a smile on the first day of school! ☺

# Second-Grade Supply List



- Children should have **at least 5 pencils** with erasers at all times
- Eraser
- 1 box of crayons (24-count)
- Colored pencils (**Twistables** are preferred.)
- 2 highlighters
- 1 **small** pencil box
- 1 three-ring binder, 1" wide
- 1 two-pocket folder
- 4 large glue sticks
- Children's scissors
- Small pencil sharpener with shavings holder
- 2 boxes of tissues to share with the class
- Art smock labeled with your child's name

During the school year, please periodically ask your child if he or she needs to replenish any supplies.

## Third-Grade Supply List

- Loose-leaf paper, wide-ruled
- Crayons (**24-pack**, please; larger boxes do not fit well in desks.)
- Colored pencils
- 1 highlighter
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 dozen #2 pencils (*No mechanical pencils, please.*)
- Scissors
- Separate eraser (*A basic 2" pink one works well.*)
- 2 pocket folders
- Paint smock or old shirt for art class
- 1 box of tissues
- Pencil box or pencil pouch to hold supplies (*Not too large; we will have textbooks in our desks.*)
- 1 one-subject, spiral-bound notebook, wide-ruled

**Other:** Assignment planners will be provided.

Additional Supplies will be requested by individual teachers when you are notified in August.

## Supplies needed for Fourth Grade



The following supplies are required by all fourth-grade teachers:

- #2 pencils (3 at a time in school)
- eraser
- blue or black pens (2 at a time)
- loose-leaf paper (2 packs for the year)
- scissors
- colored pencils (12-pack is fine)
- glue sticks (3 for the year)
- combination metric/standard ruler
- box of tissues for the class
- smock for art

\*When class lists are finalized in August, individual teachers may request additional supplies.

\*\*Assignment pads will be provided free of charge.

### Helpful Hints:

**Please do not bring anything else** as we have no room for it, and it only leads to organizational issues.

**Label everything.** You can scrape off some of the paint at the eraser end of your pencils and write your name on the bare wood.

Don't forget to **read, study all your number facts and work on your summer learning pack** over the vacation!
