SUBJECT: PROCEDURE FOR PUBLIC REFERENDUM

Personal registration of voters at school meetings, votes, and elections in the school district is provided through Section 2014 of the New York State Education Law and any amendments thereto.

Effective for the annual school district election on May 16, 2006 and thereafter, the District shall be divided into five (5) election districts pursuant to Section 2017 of the New York State Education Law. The boundaries of each election district established by this resolution shall be the attendance boundaries of each of the school district's five (5) elementary schools. The election districts established are as follows:

Election District No. 1 – Voting Place: Clayton Avenue Elementary School (please see street listing and map for boundaries of election district number 1)

Election District No. 2 – Voting Place: Tioga Hills Elementary School (please see street listing and map for boundaries of election district number 2)

Election District No. 3 – Voting Place: Glenwood Elementary School (please see street listing and map for boundaries of election district number 3)

Election District No. 4 – Voting Place: African Road Elementary School (please see street listing and map for boundaries of election district number 4)

Election District No. 5 – Voting Place: Vestal Hills Elementary School (please see street listing and map for boundaries of election district number 5)
