Board President Michon Stuart reported:

The NYSSBA Annual Convention was very educational. Vestal's Chemistry Magic Show was featured. Jerry Etingoff said this was the best he has attended; there is information and handouts from the convention available on the NYSSBA website. Linda Daino said she attended a workshop on violence and reported that most bullying and violent incidents occur on buses; she said that character education programs are vital to reducing these incidents. Sylvia Place attended a workshop on superintendent searches and reported that it is recommended that boards of education survey a wide group of stakeholders for their input. Regarding bullving, districts with a high number of students at or below poverty levels have a higher number of bullying incidents. Jerry Etingoff also reported that the NYSSBA website also has a section on snapshots of superintendents.

Liaisons: Rick Bray reported that the Clayton Avenue Monster Mash is scheduled for 10/29. He also attended a District Planning Group meeting, which focused on literacy. He was impressed with what the district is doing. He also said that African Road Elementary student government is impressive, with students who lose elections becoming members of committees.

Michon reported that the girls' soccer team has won their 2nd straight STAC title. Board members have received a tri-fold regarding information on the 11/17/15 vote. Collaboration with Binghamton City Schools is continuing, with focus on academics and social activities. Letters of appreciation and certificates were given to each board member from BTSBA chair John Paske, in recognition of School Board Appreciation Week.

12 Master Teachers were recognized for their achievement. Laura Lamash explained that this is the 2nd year cohort and required 50 hours per year of collaboration and development.

Laura Lamash attended the Golden Circle of Bands competition. It was well-organized and a wonderful event.

Mark LaRoach also reported that SED accepted our hardship request regarding the APPR waiver.

A public hearing for the 11/17 vote will be held on 11/10, to establish a capital reserve fund for future construction and maintenance. This will be funded by any future excess revenues, to help offset local tax burdens.
