At 6:05 pm, a public hearing was opened on the District-Wide Safety Plan. There were no visitors or Board of Education members with any questions or comments. The public hearing was closed at 6:06 pm.

The Board meeting was called to order at 6:06 pm by Board of Education President Dinno Nistico in the Board Conference Room of the Administration Building. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

On motion by Mark Browning, second by Shoba Agneshwar, the Board voted 9 to 0 to adjourn immediately into Executive Session to discuss the recommendations from the Committee on Preschool Special Education and the Committee on Special Education, as well as to receive updates on negotiations with AVSP and a personnel matter.

On motion by Eric LaClair, second by Linda Daino, the Board voted 8 to 0 to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of July 26, 2022 as written. Tony Turnbull abstained.

David Degnon, Senior Associate of Highland Associates, gave a presentation on what their company has to offer the Vestal Central School District in terms of Architectural and Engineering Services for the upcoming Capital Project.

# Board President Dinno Nistico reported on the following:

--Liaison Reports: Mark Browning attended a Suicide Prevention Symposium and discussed the importance of engagement as a means to improve mental health and decrease suicide. He stated how pleased he is that Vestal has so many extracurricular programs to offer our students, as well as willing coaches. Kathryn Egan highlighted the PTO/PTA programs in our school buildings and encouraged parent participation as a means of engagement.

--Dinno reminded BOE members of the summer BBQ at the Admin Building on Tuesday, 8/30 at noon where they will have the opportunity to meet new District instructional staff and administrators.

Superintendent Jeffrey Ahearn reported on the following:

--The District was hoping to expand our SRO program through Tioga County in order to have an SRO assigned to Tioga Hills Elementary School. However, the county notified the District that there is not enough interest in Tioga County schools in order to establish such a program.

--The Vestal Police Department is putting on a community safety presentation on Wednesday, 8/24 at 6 pm in the ARE Auditorium. Registration is required through the VPD.

--Patrick Clarke shared that the District is working with Champions to establish before and after school childcare. However, they are waiting for NYS certification and plan for a January 2023 start date.

--Patrick also shared various community partnerships the District has developed: <u>Big Brothers Big Sisters</u> – This is a pilot program where VHS students will be trained as mentors and matched with CAE students. Students can receive volunteer service credit for participating (NHS, PIG, IB). There is no cost to the District.

<u>BU SWAP (Substitutes With A Purpose)</u> – BU students will be assigned to classrooms where they will observe as part of their course credit, as well as substitute in the teacher's absence.

<u>BU Teacher Apprentice Program</u> – Students enrolled in the BU Teaching, Learning, and Educational Leadership program will be assigned to a classroom where they will report every day for observation, as well as substituting when necessary. We plan to have two apprentices working with the District this year.

<u>Affiliation Agreements</u> – The District has instituted several affiliation agreements with local colleges and universities to allow for student teacher placements throughout the Vestal School District. We have seven student teachers who will be working with us this year.

<u>Binghamton University Fest</u> – Patrick Clarke, Dawn Young, and Merryl Wallach will be present at the Binghamton University Fest on August 20<sup>th</sup> to recruit substitutes for the District (clerical, cleaners, teachers, etc.)

On motion by Laura Weisse, second by Eric LaClair, the Board voted 9 to 0 to accept Schedule A – Treasurer's Report July 2022, Schedule B – Year-to-Date Budget Report July 2022, and Schedule C – Schedule of Bills July 2022, as well as approve Schedule P– Personnel as amended.
