SUBJECT: THE UTILIZATION OF CONSULTANT SERVICES

Situations will conceivably arise in the operation of the School District in which administrators must seek advice and counsel from outside sources. In the event of a situation calling for expertise not existing in the personnel of the District, the administration is encouraged to seek help from outside the District. A complete understanding by the administration as to compensation for any outside advisor shall be established prior to any services being rendered.

The Board of Education shall be informed of the employment of any outside advisors on school matters. Any advisor retained by the Superintendent within budgetary allocations shall report directly to the Superintendent or his/her designee.
