SUBJECT: COMMUNICABLE DISEASES

Whenever, upon investigation and evaluation by a licensed health services provider, a student in the public schools shows symptoms of any communicable or infectious disease reportable under the public health law that imposes a significant risk of infection of others in the school, he/she may be excluded from the school and sent home expeditiously, in a safe and proper conveyance.

Regulations and procedures will be developed for dealing with communicable diseases in ways that protect the health of both students and staff while minimizing the disruption of the education process.
