SUBJECT: DECLASSIFICATION OF DISABLED STUDENTS

The Board of Education directs the Superintendent or the Superintendent's designee to establish appropriate administrative procedures for declassification of students with disabilities who no longer require special education services. Those procedures must include: factors for declassifying students where appropriate, process for reevaluating the student prior to declassification, and procedures for provision of educational and support services to the student upon declassification.
