SUBJECT: DISTRIBUTION, IMPLEMENTATION, AND CONFIDENTIALITY OF IEPs

Each regular education teacher, special education teacher, related service provider and other service provider who is responsible for the implementation of a student's individualized education program (IEP) shall be given a copy of the student's IEP prior to the implementation of such program. The contents of the IEP shall remain confidential and shall not be disclosed to any other person. The Chairperson of the Committee on Special Education (CSE) shall designate, prior to the implementation of the IEP, a professional employee of the School District with knowledge of the student's disability and education program who shall inform each teacher, assistant and support staff person of their responsibility relating to the implementation of the IEP and the specific accommodations, modifications, and supports that must be provided to the student in accordance with the IEP.
