SUBJECT: OBJECTION TO INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS

Any criticism of instructional materials that are in the schools should be submitted in writing to the Superintendent. The Board of Education will be informed. A committee will be designated by the Superintendent to investigate the challenged material according to the principles and qualitative standards stated in Policy #8320, Selection of Library and Multimedia Materials, and make a recommendation to the Superintendent of Schools. The Superintendent of Schools will make a decision, which is subject to appeal to the Board of Education.
