

2007 Hall of Fame Honoree

Bess Greenberg Class of 1997

Named the Most Valuable Player of Denmark's Virum Basketball Club in 2003 and of the Israeli Cup Tournament in 2006, along with being the recipient of the Jack Kent Cooke Scholar Award in 2006, Bess Greenberg has accomplished in a decade what others might in a lifetime.

The accolades came early in her career at Vestal, where she scored numerous awards as a member of the Varsity Girls' Basketball Team, including a STAC Scoring title. Her other achievements were just as noteworthy. A member of the Honor Society, she was also voted Homecoming Queen in 1996.

Ms. Greenberg continued to achieve success at Binghamton University, both athletically and academically. She was a two-time Academic and Athletic All-American, and was also named Conference Player of the Year and ECAC Player of the Year.

Her future promises even more success as she turns her focus to another interest, photography. Currently, Ms. Greenberg is pursuing her Master's degree from Bard College in conjunction with the International Center of Photography.

After returning from a stay in Denmark, Ms. Greenberg plans to settle near her brothers in New York City but will return to Vestal often to visit her parents.
