## **Class of 1987**

After graduating from high school, Carl received his B.S. from Cornell, his M.S. from the University of Dayton and his Ph.D. from the University of Dayton.

Carl Boehlert's research in the field of materials science has earned him numerous honors and awards, including a 2004 Presidential Early Career Award for Scientists and Engineers (PECASE), an award honoring the nation's most promising young researchers. An assistant professor of materials and science at Michigan State University, Boehlert's current research, being funded through the PECASE program and the National Science Foundation, involves structural alloys and grain boundary engineering. Prior to joining the MSU faculty, the class of 1987 graduate was a researcher and assistant professor at Alfred University.
