As a result, Broome County is under a State of Emergency and local school districts are closed through April 13th, with students returning to school on April 14th. If your student needs to retrieve a personal or academic item, please call the school so the item can be ready for you to pick up. After 3 pm on Friday, the school buildings will not be accessible.
