I know these first five months have not been without challenges. However, I am extremely impressed by your dedication to ensure we offer the very best to our students, both inside and outside the classroom. Our educational approach is second to none!

Part of having a great school system is promoting health and safety for our students, faculty, and staff. We currently have four School Resource Officers and engaged in conversations with the Town of Vestal last summer to add two more SROs. Since then, there has been a change in Town of Vestal leadership. Although I have met with the new Town Supervisor on numerous occasions and shared the various ways the Town of Vestal and the Vestal School District have collaborated over the years, it has been made clear that she is not supportive of two additional VPD SROs and is now reconsidering the commitment of active-duty Vestal police officers in our schools past June 2025.

As a result, I have addressed the Town of Vestal Board on two occasions, advocating for the addition of two SROs and to maintain the four SROs that we currently have. I will continue to advocate for our SROs and will take every opportunity to speak to the importance and benefits of having Vestal Police Officers in our school buildings.

On another note, we have only utilized one snow day as of this writing. Even though Punxsutawney Phil did not see his shadow, I am not optimistic that Spring is on its way... I'm sure we are in for some snowy weather in the weeks to come! Looking ahead, we do not have school on February 16 and 19 in recognition of Presidents Day. 


