We continue to provide SEL to each classroom every week or bi-weekly!

In kindergarten we are working on feeling identification. Most recently we are talking about feeling confident and happy! In first grade, we just finished talking about how people can have different emotions to the

same thing!

In second grade, we have moved into our emotion management unit where we are focusing on how to recognize and support our own emotions. If we don't take care of our own feelings - we might flip our lid! In third grade, we just finished up talking about different types of conflict. We talked about the difference between disagreements, rude and mean moments and bullying. In fourth grade and fifth grade, Officer Talbut and I just completed our social media safety lessons. We discussed everything we should know when navigating social media, video games, and texting. In <u>fifth grade,</u> we have also just started to talk about transitioning to VMS! WOW!

In <u>kindergarten</u>, <u>1st</u> and <u>2nd</u> grade we are working on recognizing how we are feeling and expanding our emotional vocabularies. Your students can tell you about Scribble Spot and Happiness Spot from the Little Spot series!

In third and fourth grade, I challenged your students to identify as many feeling words as they can - they were able to identify over 20 different feeling words! Now we are working on understanding facial expressions, body language, and tone of voice. We used our skills to play charades - they did a great job! In fifth grade, we are working on respecting similarities and differences in our friends. We are also talking about what we can say outloud and what should stay in our heads. We can be friends even with all our differences.




