Health & Safety Sub Committee: Focus Points

- Next steps for increasing to four days/week of in-person instruction for grade K-5 students to commence March 29, 2021
- Next steps for increasing to four days/week of in-person instruction for grade 6-12 students



Health & Safety Sub Committee: Protocols

Transportation

- Seating charts kept for each bus route
- Increased bus capacity
 - Two students per seat (maximum capacity is approximately 40 students per bus)

Classrooms

- Social distancing-reduced to three feet with face masks and barriers
- Desk barriers expected to be delivered Friday, March 26, 2021



Health & Safety Sub Committee: Protocols

Daily Screenings

- Temperature checks – we will maintain this practice
- Screening forms – we will maintain this practice
- Update screening form on April 1, 2021 per new NYS domestic travel guidelines (quarantine not required after entering NYS from another US state or US territory)

Facilities

- Maintain cleaning and disinfection schedules/procedures
 - The desk barriers will be added to the clean/disinfect schedules/procedures

Food service

- Can accommodate increased student meals in schools and continue delivery of meals as needed



Health & Safety Sub Committee: Quarantine Procedures

- Anyone within a six-foot distance of a COVID - 19 positive individual for more than 10 minutes will be quarantined. Anyone within six-feet to 12 feet for more than 45 minutes will be quarantined
- All individuals quarantined will be notified through our contact tracing procedures in conjunction with local Health Department(s)
- There is the potential for more students/staff to be quarantined due to decreased social distancing radius of three feet with barriers in classrooms
- Accurate classroom attendance is essential for contact tracing
- Transportation (bus) seating charts will continue to be created and adhered to for accurate contact tracing
