An outstanding football and baseball player, he was named to the STAC All Conference Football Team, the New York All-State Football Team and the Sunkist Prep All-American Team where he was selected as captain. John received a full football scholarship to the University of Maryland.

At Maryland, John started as a wide receiver in his sophomore year. In his senior year, he was the team's co-captain, made the All-Atlantic Coast Conference Academic Team, was the MVP, led the nation in kick-off returns and was chosen to play in the Coaches All-American Game.

As a football free agent in 1976, he was selected by the Denver Broncos as a wide receiver, punt returner and specialty team member. He played professional football for four years. In 1977, John was selected as co-captain of the Broncos. That year the team won the AFC Championship and played in Super Bowl XII.
