

Excerpt from Citation

For conspicuous gallantry and intrepidity at the risk of his life above and beyond the call of duty......By his outstanding valor, indomitable fighting spirit and tenacious determination in the face of overwhelming odds, Sgt. Peters upheld the highest traditions of the Marine Corps and the U.S. Naval Service. He gallantly gave his life for his country.

Lawrence D. Peters Memorial Scholarship

Background

The \$1,000 scholarship is awarded in memory of Binghamton native Marine Sgt. Lawrence David Peters. Sergeant Peters received our Nation's highest honor for valor, the Medal of Honor, for "outstanding valor, indomitable fighting spirit and tenacious determination in the face of overwhelming odds" during the action which took his life on 4 September 1967 in the Republic of Vietnam.

This scholarship is presented to perpetuate his memory and perpetuate the legacy of Sgt. Peters through an individual who best exemplifies them and to encourage them to fulfil their academic and career goals while reinforcing positive core values and life skills.

Eligibility

The scholarship is open to graduating Broome County high school seniors who are children or grandchildren of veterans who are residents of Broome County or were at the time of their death.

Application Procedure

- ✓ Return the completed application and the enclosures requested below.
- ✓ Enclose a copy of grade 9-12 (including up to 3rd marking period for senior year) transcript and estimated final class standing.
- ✓ Enclose an essay of 300 words or less indicating why the award of this scholarship is important to you. Relate your essay to the core values demonstrated by Sgt. Peters and how they relate to you, your life, education, work and community service experiences and career goals. Include any other pertinent information relative to why you feel the scholarship is especially important to you.
