Dr. Kerr received a B.A. in biology from Hamilton College. He attended Upstate Medical School in Syracuse where he received his M.D. He completed his surgical internship and residency and his plastic surgery residency at Upstate Medical School. Ivy Society of Plastic & Reconstructive Surgeons and received Dual Board Certification in General Surgery and Plastic Surgery.
