

Mark Mysnyk, M.D.

Mark was the valedictorian of his graduating class at Vestal and a wrestling standout at Vestal and the University of Iowa where he received his bachelor's and doctorate degrees. He was a two-time New York State High School Wrestling Champion, a two-time Junior National champion, a member of the University of Iowa's NCAA Wrestling Championship teams, a first alternate for the USA Olympic Free style Wrestling Team, and he placed fifth in the World University Games in Sofia, Bulgaria. He was a Rhodes Scholar nominee in 1979 and the recipient of the Stevens Memorial Scholarship in 1977.

He has worked as the orthopedic resident and the assistant wrestling team physician at the University of Iowa, a medical staff member *for* the Junior Olympics and the NCAA Division I Wrestling Championships, editor of the Iowa Orthopedic Journal, and practicing partner at the Steindler Orthopedic Clinic. He has presented at dozens of medical symposiums and workshops, published three books and numerous papers. He is currently the clinical assistant professor of orthopedics at the University of Iowa and the tournament physician at the Junior National Greco-Roman Wrestling Tournament.
