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Vestal Youth Police Academy kicks off on Monday, July 10

In partnership with the Vestal Police Department, the Vestal High School will offer its annual Youth Police Academy to area students in grades 8 - 12. This year's Academy will focus on offering workshops and other training to middle school students from July 10 – 14, 2023. The schedule for Academy cadets in high school will be July 17 – 28. This is the 11th year for the Youth Police Academy, a leadership-based program hosted on the Vestal High School campus.

Cadets begin each day with physical fitness training, and then engage in workshops and presentations. Demonstrations and interactive scenarios include active listening, defensive training, drug and alcohol prevention, first aid, team-building and more. In addition to instruction by officers from the Vestal Police Department, cadets will be instructed by SWAT, CSI, K9, National Guard and other trainers. This year's academy, coordinated by Vestal Central Schools' SRO Conor Talbut, will also include educational sessions by STOP-DWI, LifeNet, Vestal Fire and Vestal EMS representatives.
