Since 2004, Vestal Elks Lodge 2508 has donated over 5,200 dictionaries to third-graders in Vestal Schools! We are incredibly grateful for their support of our students and appreciate this annual gift that provides a wonderful tool for enhancing their literacy skills. Having access to a dictionary helps students build their vocabulary, and having an extensive vocabulary is a key factor in academic success.

The Elks work in conjunction with The Dictionary Project, a nonprofit organization, to assist all students in completing the school year as good writers, active readers, creative thinkers and resourceful learners. Thanks to civic organizations all over the country, such as Vestal Elks Lodge 2508, 36.1 million children have received their very own dictionaries, over 450,000 this year alone.
